  2. Trot a serpentine around marker A, B and C (between markers min. 7m)
  3. At D stop and perform a 360° turn
  4. Walk a circle around marker D
  5. Trot a U turn as drawn
  6. Stop and perform 1 ¼ turn
  7. Walk to the judge
  8. Set up
  9. Inspection
  10. When dismissed, back up one horse length
- Pattern completed, exit at at walk or trot

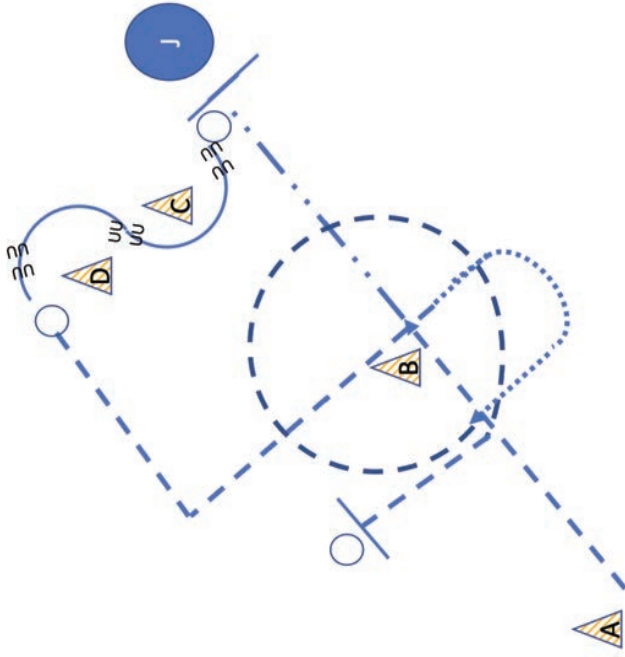

  7. Inspection
  8. When dismissed, back up as shown
  9. Trot a square corner
  10. At marker C stop
  11. Perform a 180° turn
  12. Set up for a brief inspection

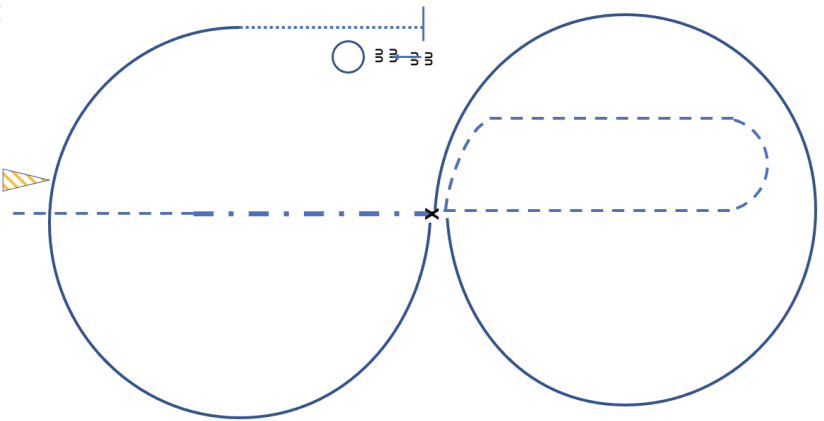

  9. Walk a U turn as drawn
  10. Trot a circle around marker B
  11. Continue on a straight line
  12. Stop between marker C and D
  13. Perform a 540° turn
  14. Set up your horse for a brief inspection

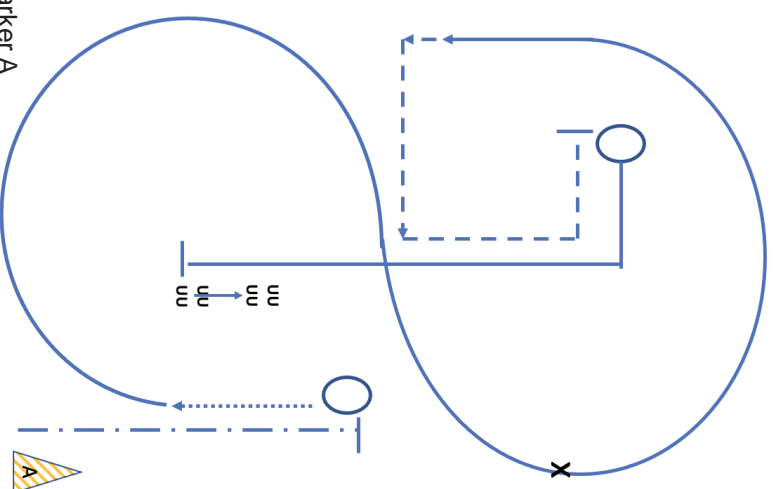

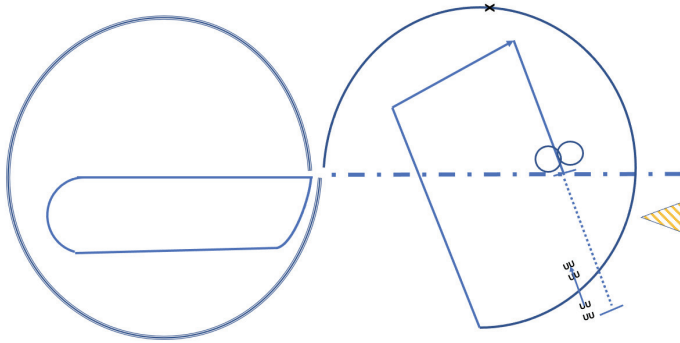

  9.  $1\frac{1}{2}$  turn left or right
- Pattern is completed, exit at the walk or jog

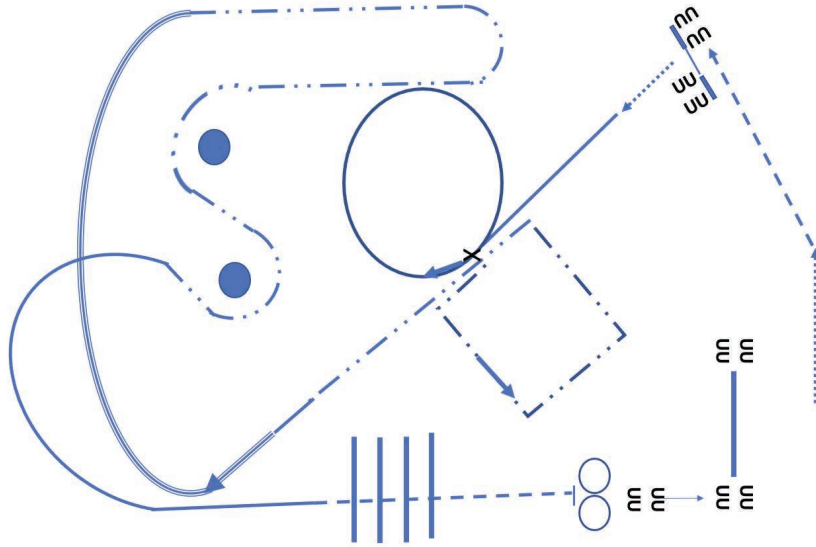

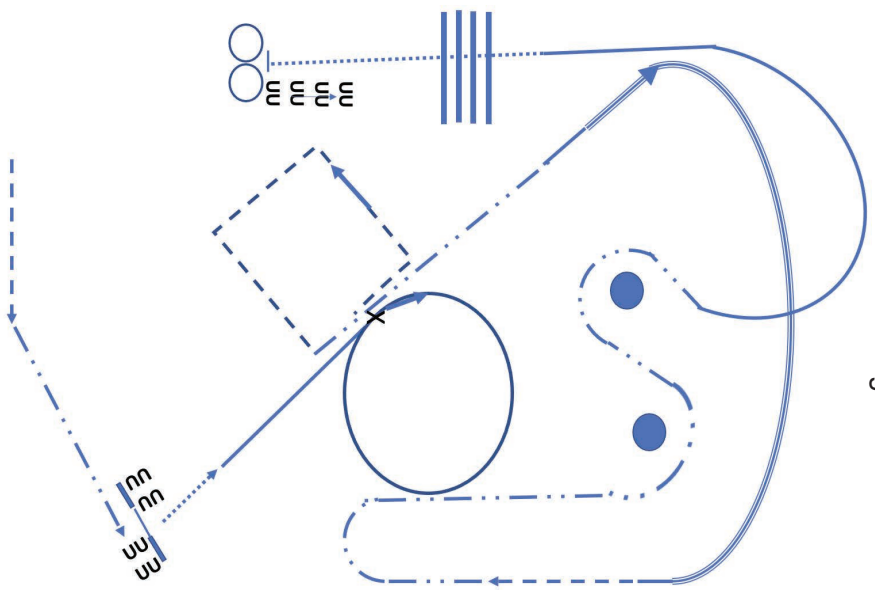

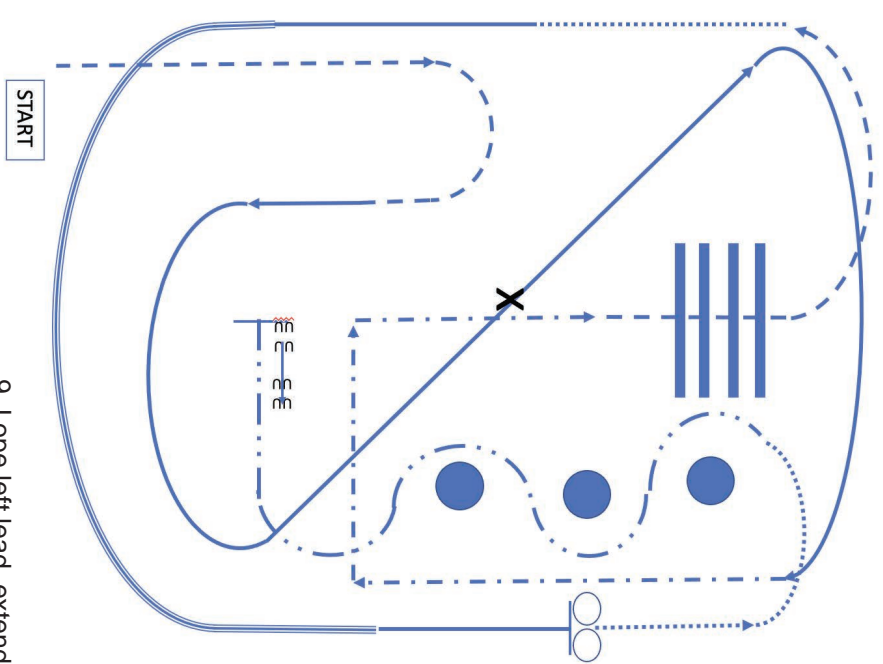
